TRADE TERMS & CONDITIONS

By submitting your booking form you agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. You will only be booked into the event on receipt of a completed booking form with full payment. Please note that if we cannot accept your booking we will contact you to let you know.
2. All completed relevant paperwork must be submitted with the booking form.
3. Unless you have booked an indoor pitch or market stall stand, your booking is for an outdoor pitch only and does not include any electric hook up/furniture/gazebos etc. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own chairs, tables, generators, chilled cabinets, hobs, freezers, cleaning products and kitchenware etc.
4. Exhibitors are welcome to use their own quiet diesel generators outside but must notify the organisers in advance by declaring this on their booking form.
5. Exhibitors using gas or other fuels must disclose this on their booking form. All such exhibitors must confirm that all additional health and safety/fire regulations and risk assessment processes in respect thereof have been conformed with. All such exhibitors must bring their own appropriate firefighting equipment (fire blanket/fire extinguisher).
6. All exhibitors must ensure that all walkways and exits are kept clear at all times.
7. If any cooking is taking place on your stand, you must supply a fire blanket/fire extinguisher.
8. You are responsible for meeting all environmental health and trading standards legislation. A TENS license is in place for Bakewell Country Festival.
9. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if extreme weather conditions persist or other unforeseen circumstances beyond the organisers' control mean that the running of the event would be contrary to health and safety. Under these circumstances refunds would not be given.
10. In the event that Bakewell Country Festival cannot take place due to the implementation of Covid-19 restrictions a refund will not be given but all bookings and stall fees paid will be transferred to a future event.
11. Bakewell Country Festival are not responsible for loss of earnings under any circumstances.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for clearing all rubbish from their stand/pitch and placing it into the skips provided. Bread crates and gas canisters must not be put in the skips, they must be removed from the site by exhibitors.
13. The organisers will try to ensure a variety of stalls but cannot guarantee the number of stalls per type or what other stalls will be selling (i.e. similar products as secondary products). Priority will be given to local and award-winning exhibitors/produce. Stands/pitches will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis.
14. Please ensure that all environmental health, appropriate health and safety standards and hygiene standards are fully certified and practices are upheld throughout the event. Exhibitors must conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times during the event. Failure of the aforementioned will result in you being asked to leave the event with no refund.
