TRADE TERMS & CONDITIONS

IMPORTANT: Bookings are limited due to space restrictions within the Agricultural Business Centre and priority will be given to local traders/produce. Successful applicants will be notified via email.

By submitting your booking form you agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. You will only be booked into the event on receipt of a completed booking form and full payment by Monday 25th November 2024.
2. **Trade fees are non-refundable** but may be transferred to a future event, should there be availability.
3. Payment for your pitch must be made by the date specified in your booking confirmation email, otherwise your booking will be void and allocated to the first trader on the standby list.
4. All paperwork relevant to your business (e.g. public liability insurance and food hygiene certificate) must be completed and submitted with the booking form.
5. Your booking is for your pitch only and does not include any electric hook up/other furniture/gazebos etc., other than a market stall if you have booked one (indoor stalls and tables include one chair). You are responsible for providing your own diesel generators, chilled cabinets, hobs, freezers, cleaning products and kitchenware etc. as required.
6. You may use your own quiet modern DIESEL generator outside but must notify Bakewell Agricultural & Horticultural Society (BAHS) in advance by declaring this on your booking form. **STRICTLY NO PETROL GENERATORS ALLOWED.**
7. If you are using gas or other fuels you must disclose this on your booking form. All such traders must confirm that all additional health and safety/fire regulations and risk assessment processes in respect thereof have been conformed with. All such traders must bring their own appropriate firefighting equipment (fire blanket/fire extinguisher).
8. You must ensure that all walkways and exits are kept clear at all times.
9. You are responsible for meeting all environmental health and trading standards legislation.
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if extreme weather conditions persist or other unforeseen circumstances beyond the organisers' control mean that the running of the event would be contrary to health and safety. Under these circumstances refunds would **not** be given but all bookings and stall fees paid will be transferred to a future event.
11. The organisers are not responsible for loss of earnings under any circumstances.
12. Traders are responsible for clearing all rubbish from their stand/pitch.
13. The organisers will try to ensure a variety of stalls but cannot guarantee the number of stalls per type or what other stalls will be selling (i.e. similar products as secondary products). Priority will be given to local traders/produce. Stands/pitches will be allocated on arrival on a first-come first-served basis.
14. Please ensure that all environmental health, appropriate health and safety standards and hygiene standards are fully certified and practices are upheld throughout the event. Exhibitors must conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times during the event. Failure of the aforementioned will result in you being asked to leave the event with no refund.
15. Traders are not permitted to pack down and leave the site until after the event closes at 4pm.
